Palisades State Park

One of the most beautiful, unique and serene state parks in South Dakota. Located 2 miles south of Garretson. Colorful red quartzite pinnacles and formations with 50 foot vertical cliffs line Split Rock River, which flows through the park. Modern camping facilities & camping cabins are available. Devil's Gulch

Stand on the footbridge spanning the chasm of Devil's Gulch and imagine the pounding of horses' hooves, echoing gun shots and shouts of a posse as they pursue outlaw Jesse James. Hike the scenic trails to Devil's Falls and the Devil's Stairway. Free entrance May - October.

Split Rock Park

Enjoy quartzite rock formations along Split Rock River and interesting architecture of the Works Progress Administration of the 1930's, featuring a dam with waterfall, bathhouse, bridges and rock wall with flower garden. Primitive camping - 11 electrical pads, canoeing, fishing, hiking and picnicking. Camping Reservations call 605-594-2225.
