Committee Reports:

Minnehaha County Sheriff – Capt. Walsh presented information to the council about the past year's services. Capt. Walsh began as Minnehaha County Sheriff Captain on November 20th. The past year, there have been 35 citations issued and 12 warnings. Those citations included 8 DUI's. There was also 8 funeral assists. There were 992 calls for service which averages 82 calls per month. Mondays, Fridays, and Saturdays had the highest number of per day calls. The week of June 22, the City of Garretson was not charged for any of the hours in excess of the regular contracted hours. Every deputy available was sent to Garretson to assist. Capt. Walsh stated that the goal is to gain more law abiding citizens and to have less crime committed just by having law enforcement present and not by issuing excessive amount of tickets. Mayor Mullin brought up a few concerns expressed to him. Those included the blocking of the railroad crossing, run-off's at gas pumps, and business door checks. Hofer stated that the biggest concern brought to her attention was presentation and communicating more with the public while they are in town. Capt. Walsh requested specifics on any complaints to include date, time, and actions as generalities are difficult to correct. Uhl will be in contact with Capt. Walsh concerning blocked railroad crossings.

Garretson Fire Department – Rozeboom is the new fire chief for 2016. He stated that there were 10 calls for the month of December and 101 training/work hours. YTD calls were 155 and 2010 work hours. On Wednesday, the firemen went out and scooped paths to the fire hydrants. The residents have done a great job to keep the area around their hydrant clear of snow.

Garretson Ambulance – Penning presented. YTD there were 224 calls and most of them were nursing home calls. Penning and Nathan Leonard have been working to change policies and procedures, quality of care, and increase ALS availability. They are currently working on 3 grants which would be used for education and equipment. They are trying to save as much funds as possible and re-invest in improvements.

Natural Gas

Natural Gas Prices - Uhl presented a spreadsheet for January 2016 gas prices. In-city usage rate for small customers shall be \$.9296 per CCF, medium customers shall be \$.8966 per CCF, and large customers shall be \$.8786 per CCF. Outside city limits usage rate for small customers shall be \$.9696 per CCF, medium customers shall be \$.9366 per CCF, and large customers shall be \$.9182 per CCF. Council member Hofer made a motion to accept, Sanders 2nd, 5 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion passed.

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE WATER FEES FOR THE CITY OF GARRETSON

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARRETSON, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA, ALL AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

That pursuant to the Ordinance of the City of Garretson providing that the City Council shall establish the rates, charges and classification of Water service for the City of Garretson, said rates, charges and classification of users for Water service provided by the City of Garretson to be kept on file at the office of the City Finance Officer shall be as follows:

The classification of users for water and sewer services and natural gas shall be as follows:

Users within the City limits of Garretson, South Dakota; Users outside the City limits of Garretson, South Dakota.

The water usage rates shall be as follows:

For users within the City limits of Garretson, South Dakota: The Basic Rate shall be \$16.00 per month; The Usage Rate shall be \$.405 per one hundred gallons or \$4.10 per one thousand gallons of water used. For users outside the City limits of Garretson, South Dakota:

The Basic Rate shall be \$21.00 per month;

The Usage Rate shall be \$.525 per one hundred gallons of water or \$5.25 per one thousand gallons of water used.
